# When adding -ed or -ing suffix... -For words that end in a silent 'e', drop the 'e' and add the suffix.

-For words that end in a vowel and then a consonant, double the consonant before adding the suffix

#### <u>Possessive Noun Rules</u>

To make a singular noun

possessive, add apostrophe + s

student → student's

teacher → teacher's

Katniss → Katniss's

To make a plural noun that DOES NOT end in "s" possessive, add apostrophe + s
children → children's sheep → sheep's women → women's

To make a plural noun that DOES end in "s" possessive, add ONLY an apostrophe

boys → boys' schools → schools' characters → characters'
